Comprehensive Eye Exams

A comprehensive eye examination is more than a vision test; it offers a view of the whole eye and can identify any potential problems. Even if you do not wear glasses, regular eye exams should remain a part of your health checkups as early detection is the key to continued eye health.

With up-to-date technology, you can expect a full health eye examination including intraocular pressure measurements, OCT scanning and Optomap retinal imaging.



Dry Eye Assessments

Dry eye is a very common condition that occurs when your eyes feel discomfort due to inadequate production, distribution or quality of tears. Since tears lubricate the eyes, this results in your eyes feeling uncomfortable and scratchy. If left untreated excessive dry eye can damage and possibly scar the corneal tissue of your eyes thus impairing vision.

Our dry eye assessment involves specialized testing to determine the type of dry eye you have and to what degree. This exam includes a gauging of how many tears are being produced, the tear salt concentration, inflammation evaluation and Meibomian gland function appraisal. This allows the doctor and ocular hygienist to formulate the best course of treatment.



Contact Fittings & Lessons

We take extra care to determine your ocular health and if your eyes are suitable for contact lenses. During your contact lenses fitting, we measure your corneal curvature and evaluate your tear film. After your initial fitting, we'll book a follow-up appointment to see how well your lens trials fit and if they're providing you with clear vision.

iLux & Zest Treatments

Zest treatments are a painless and effective remedy for those suffering from eyelid inflammation, redness and irritation. Zest works by removing bacteria and demodex that live along the lash margin. The gentle exfoliation and cleansing of debris opens up the Meibomian glands to help release the oils necessary for a healthy tear film.



iLux works by warming the Meibomian glands and gently expressing the oils to unclog blockages and restore oil flow to properly lubricate the eye surface. This treatment is especially helpful to those suffering from severe dry eye. Results are fully felt after 3 months and last 6 to 12 months afterwards depending on the individual.
